Speech NZ is delighted to announce that the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) has formally recognised several of our microcredentials for equivalency.

Credentials Framework (NZQCF)

This recognition is a milestone for Speech NZ, affirming the quality and value of our courses in communication, public speaking, teaching, and performance.

While these micro-credentials are not formally part of the NZQCF, the equivalency evaluation gives students ākonga and employers a clear understanding of how each course aligns with nationally recognised levels of study and learning hours.

What This Means for Our Courses

Here is how each of our micro-credentials have been assessed by NZQA:

This recognition provides clarity and credibility. It means you can now reference your Speech NZ qualification in terms of education levels and credits.
