Syllabus reminders from NZ Examiner Karen Austin

FLEXI SPEAKING & PERFORMING

If you have two students who are going into the examination but one student is not sitting the exam please write this on the programme. The reasons for this would most likely be for a characterisation or improvisation.

PUBLIC SPEAKING & COMMUNICATION

Grade 6 Module 2 Section One
Note, it is not a requirement for the candidate to bring in a chart or poster with headlines for the talk. This is down to teacher and student preference.

ASB MODULE ONE

Section one

The historical speech given needs to be the full speech, not an excerpt.

PROFESSIONAL SPEAKING

At all three levels, it is no longer a requirement to have an audience, this is completely optional.

When creating a workplace scenario, candidates that are still in school can use their imagination to create a believable situation.

SPEECH & DRAMA

Poetry

Gesturing and actions are acceptable to emphasise words and meaning but should not dominate the poem.

Grade 5 Module 1_Section 2 & 3

Ensure that students are able to identify and discuss the different poetic devices in their poem.

Grade 6 Module 1

Students need to be able to confidently discuss and compare the three poems they take into the exam along with the poem they have memorised.

When candidates choose to read one section of the 15-minute programme, ensure that it is not the longest component of the programme! Aim to achieve an appropriate timing balance between the selected texts.





CLAIMING EXPENSES

Working from home


Take a look at <u>this guide</u> for what you can claim - it's more than you think! It includes 100% of new furniture and office supplies, 10% of lightbulbs and heating bill and more!

Work from home? Make sure you claim these expenses

If you use your home for business — whether you're a contractor, sole trader, in partnership or own a company — you can claim a portion of household expenses. You can claim 100% of expenses that are solely for business purposes eg a business phone line. For the rest, you can claim the proportion of your house that you use for work. In this example, the house is 100 square metres and the office 10 square metres — 10% of the total area. So the owner can claim 10% of expenses not solely for business, eg a power bill. Whatever you claim, remember to keep a record of each item.
